

Newport Squash Club Host British Transplant Games 2019

On Thursday 25th July, Newport Squash Club, with the help & support of Squash Wales will be hosting this year's squash event, for the Westfield Health British transplant games 2019.



The games this year is taking place in different locations across Newport, from the 25th July to 28th July.

The British transplant games will see over 950 transplant recipients taking part, in over 25 different events, with more than 1500 supporters going along to watch. Not only does the games aim to encourage transplant recipients to lead an active lifestyle, it also helps to raise awareness of the need for organ donation and to show appreciation for and remember donors and their families.



In the squash event, there are 26 transplant recipients taking part, with age groups ranging from 15 through to 70+.

They will play in a round robin format within their age groups and there will be medals for Gold, Silver and Bronze for each age category.

The opening ceremony of the British transplant games will take place at Rodney parade on Thursday 25th July 5.45pm - 8pm.
